

Year 11 2016 Results Analysis Headlines

- More pupils are achieving teacher target grades
 - More pupils are achieving more qualifications at a higher grade (- increase in points score and increase in number of equivalent GCSE qualifications), points scored from 271 in 2015 to 277 in 2016 and number of equivalent GCSE qualifications from 7.5 to 8.9
- Only 1 pupil (who was a part time pupil) did not get at least a level 1 qualification in both Maths and English
- Pupils continue to achieve higher grades with vocational qualifications rather than GCSE's with terminal examinations

How were they achieved?

- New processes were put into place to ensure that teacher target grades in all subjects are both challenging and achievable. – triangulated with FFT estimate CASPA expected progress and teacher professional knowledge of pupil, checked by SLT
- Continual analysis of pupil achievement against expected progress every half term with appropriate actions taken when needed
- CASPA allows us to show clearly progress made against similar pupils nationally and prove their progress
