Teaching and Learning, Assessment:

Planned for the second half of the Autumn term is our SIC visit and the first round of the teachers lesson observations.

We have also sourced some very high quality training for staff to continue to support them in their response to pupil need. This training focuses on Sensory need and diet, as well as environment and is intended to generate further conversation in our planned staff reflection blogs that will come on line in the next term.

We advocate our staff to the pursuit of learning that refines their skill set and this is undeniably evident in the classroom setting.

In school we continue to operate a 'basket full' of indicators that support assessment developments and offer a consistent approach. We will ensure we update Governors as these systems develop or guidance changes, to this end we held our recent update during our SLT regards FFT Aspire.
