

Governors Report for SEN, Pupil Premium and CLA

We currently have 76 students on roll at Archers Brook;

This includes 9 link students across Years 6-10. There is one student in Year 8 who is accessing the Link full time. All other are in the main area of school and in respective year groups.

We have 65 boys and 11 girls.

There are 5 Children who are looked after. All Autumn PEP's were completed and 3 out of 5 Spring PEP's already completed. The two unaccounted are due to individual students not having social workers currently.

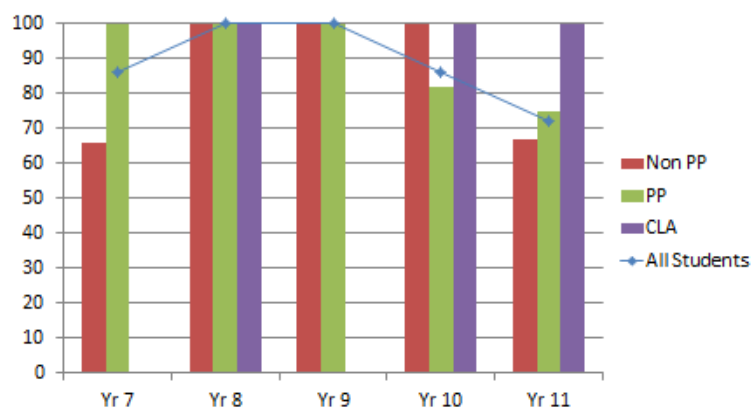
We currently have 45 students entitled to Free School Meals. This equates to 59% of the cohort.

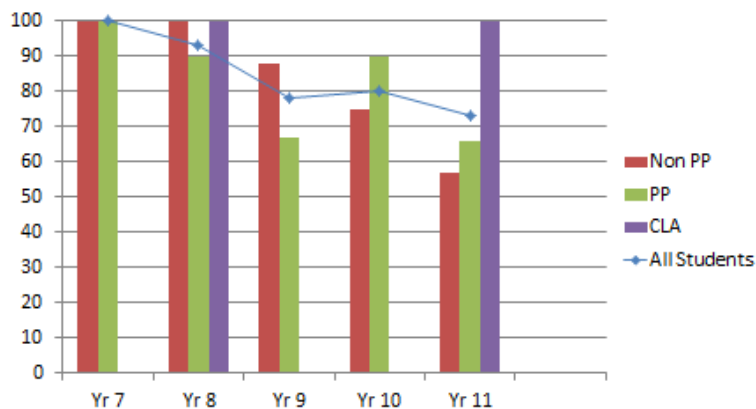
HAT 2 – Analysis Data

The data shows in both maths and English students are making expected levels of progress. There are some differences between the key groups, but the outlook for CLA is positive in regards to the progress being made by the whole cohort.

Analysis of reading data has been undertaken and a plan moving forward to improve the reading SAS across the whole school will be audited by the SENCo. Ideas to improve students reading to build confidence and self-esteem include, intensive reading scheme, long term reading scheme, reading lessons and story telling.

Contact has been made with National Autistic Society about the Autism Accreditation award. This is so that a recognised award can be gained to show the outstanding provision for students with ASC benefit from at Archers Brook. A meeting with Liz Eddowes the local representative for NAS is currently being organised.

The Basic Skills Quality Mark was renewed in September with glowing reports from assessor. Some basic feedback points regarding stronger links with post 16 providers and to increase opportunities to share good practice with other local providers.
