

GOVERNERS UPDATE May 2017

SDP Update – Review recording of attendance policy and research ‘live’ recording system. JHi, M.B

The overall attendance for this year up to 12th May 2017 is 88.7% compared to 88.0 % for the equivalent time last year. Year group breakdown below;

KS2	92%
Yr 7	93%
Yr8	89%
Yr9	90%
Yr10	83%
Yr11	86%

Two pupils in Yr10 have been persistent school non-attenders throughout the academic year. After much work one has reengaged with school and has pleasing attendance. (64% since Christmas) Out of school agencies are still working with the Family to look at ways forward. Pupil A has had some sporadic attendance but is struggling with the boundaries set in school and off-site provisions are being sought for next academic year. Pupil B in Yr10 and Pupil C in Yr8 have both disengaged with school with the Assessment Team looking at ways forward. Yr 11 still has the lowest attendance due to the complexity of pupils within that year and the packages they can engage in.

If we look at unauthorised attendance, 5 pupils account for 74% of the total.

Pupil B 114

Pupil C 92 This gives 928 out of 1266 which

Pupil D 144 equals 73% of total unauthorised

Pupil E 254

If we put this as a percentage of our total attendance it is 4.2%

If we do the same for school holidays it is 0.7%

Combined this is affecting our attendance by nearly 5%
